# DetecTogether: New Name, New Look, Same Mission

Founders **Jim and Nancy Coghlin** and their family initially became involved with fundraising to help others survive cancer 40 years ago when they lost a dear friend to the disease. Through that work, they learned in 2008 that survival rates for 15-40 year-olds with cancer had barely improved since the 1970s. One significant factor was that cancer was often diagnosed too late.

The Coghlins looked for an organization to support that was empowering people with life-saving knowledge to help detect cancer earlier. There were none, so the Coghlins founded 15-40 Connection, and initially focused on educating young adults.

It quickly became clear that **people of all ages needed to learn how to detect cancer early** and, more recently, that **the organization's name should change to reflect that broader scope.** On January 7, 2021, a new name and brand identity were revealed:

# Do You Know Why We Are So Passionate About What We Do?

People often remark that we are a very passionate team. We will do everything in our power to save lives by teaching people how to detect cancer early and be active partners in their health care. Do you know why we are so passionate?

It is not solely because of alarming statistics such as when the National Academies of Science, Engineering and Medicine reported that delayed diagnosis was a major problem in healthcare that will impact all of us, sometimes with devastating consequences. It's also because we have felt these statistics. At one time we did not know how to detect cancer early and people in our lives paid a price for that. We do not want this to happen to you.

Our passion also comes from experiences like that of our Executive Director Tricia Laursen's mother. Her cancer diagnosis was delayed six months because her screening

results were delayed. Her cancer advanced unchecked during that time making it more challenging to treat and less likely to be cured. Prior to learning that her cancer had returned,

her initial symptoms were dismissed for months by her doctor. While she lived six years after her initial diagnosis, her life was cut short. She missed meeting two of her grandchildren, one by only a month, and all of her grandchildren missed out on the positive influence she surely would have had on their lives.

Too many of us have similar stories. It is particularly painful when they involve loved ones at much younger ages. We wish we could turn back the clock. We can't do that for them, but with our 3 Steps Detect roadmap to early cancer detection, we can change the outcome for others.

#### FIREFIGHTER PROGRAM

#### We've Launched Online Learning for Firefighters

With support from FEMA, we built and launched Online Learning: Helping Firefighters Beat Cancer to scale and deliver our education to firefighters across the country and in Canada. Occupational cancer is a critical issue facing firefighters.

Detect, which teaches first responders how to detect cancer early,

when it's most treatable, and 10 micro-courses on related topics such as: "Identifying and Tracking Symptoms," "Why Are Some People At Greater Risk," "How To Do Self-Exams," among others. Developed with the assistance of our Fire Service Advisory Board, whose expertise and experience span research, firefighting, and cancer fighting, this program can be accessed on computers and mobile devices, at no cost.



#### DetecTogether Holds Free Cancer Screening for Firefighters at Polar Park

Responding to requests from central MA departments, DetecTogether organized a free cancer screening for firefighters. Polar Park hosted the event, and UMass Memorial Health provided doctors, medical students, hospital staff, and equipment, so that firefighters could receive a free skin screening, part of Step 1, knowing "your great." Firefighters

from 30 cities and towns attended. We were joined by guests **Lt. Governor Karyn Polito**, **Worcester Red Sox President Dr. Charles Steinberg**, and **State Representative Hannah Kane**.

In all, 115 firefighters were screened for skin cancer. 35 required biopsies, which were scheduled onsite.

# **IMPACT**

#### DetecTogether Presents at National Conferences with FEMA Grant Partners

As part of our FEMA Fire Prevention and Safety Grant, we collaborated with partners, The Firefighter Cancer Support Network and the Center for Fire, Rescue & EMS Health Research, to reduce cancer mortality in the fire service and presented at four national conferences, including:

#### **Trainings Cause Life-Saving Action**

**CORY B.** After we taught 3 Steps Detect in Lancaster, MA, we heard from a 37 year-old firefighter. For four years, he had been having symptoms. He told us, "My skin was red and itchy and flaking. I was losing my hair where it was red. I didn't think anything of it but went to a dermatologist. They did a test and said it was an allergic reaction to something but they didn't know what. But the 'allergies' didn't improve with treatment."

"I let it go until you guys came out to my fire department for a class last October. I got thinking more about it. It pushed me to go back to my doctor to get it checked out again. That's when I learned I had been misdiagnosed and I actually have cancer — Cutaneous T Cell Lymphoma."

**MIKE FAGAN** When DetecTogether began to focus efforts on teaching firefighters, longtime supporter and **1A Auto CEO Rick Green** and his team stepped in to help. They have generously sponsored DetecTogether's in-person education, including a training held last fall in Norwood, MA, which helped save the life of **Firefighter Mike Fagan**.

Fagan learned **3 Steps Detect** at his firehouse, and reported to us that our class **saved his life**. He put 3 Steps Detect into action, sharing health changes with his doctor and advocating for himself. A follow-up colonoscopy revealed that he had colon cancer, caught at Stage 2B. Had he waited, the path forward would have been much more difficult.

# WORCESTER

RYAN KELLEY, 35, learned 3 Steps Detect at his Worcester firehouse, and realized he should get a scab that wouldn't heal checked out by a doctor. "I probably waited a ridiculous amount of time... but the training you did caused a bell to go off." Ryan then attended the skin screening, and subsequently had skin cancer diagnosed and removed. "Now I'm doing great," Ryan says, "and I can't thank you guys enough for what you're doing for all of us."

#### **BOSTON**

We conducted training at the oldest fire department in the country, in Boston, over eight weeks, twice a day, four days per-week, and taught 1,400 firefighters. A post-training survey asked how valuable they found the training to be. The average score on a scale of 1-10 was a 9.8.

The training was sponsored by McGovern Auto Group and the Last Call Foundation.

#### DONOR SPOTLIGHT

#### **BRYAN & JUDY RICH**

Bryan and Judy Rich have been longtime supporters of our work. From the early days of the golf tournament to the evolution to DetecTogether, their advice and generosity have been invaluable. In 2021, their transformative gift of \$250,000 allowed us to prepare to bring the Response Time Matters national health campaign to life.

Bryan and Judy challenged us to use their gift to inspire others, and by year-end, we had raised an additional \$550,000 in overall support. The public health initiative launched in Boston this fall before rolling out nationwide.











During the 8-week Boston firefighter training program, which ran from September–December 2021, we taught 1,400 members of the Boston Fire Department.

#### **Golf Fights Cancer**

In 2021, DetecTogether participated in our first Golf Fights Cancer (GFC) Golf Marathon. GFC is another organization deeply committed to fighting cancer and saving lives. Forty three DetecTogether golfers participated, and together raised \$512,350. The partnership exceeded all expectations.

"The excitement for the event was amazing, as is the collective power of our fundraisers," says GFC Chairman & Co-Founder, Brian Oates. "It's incredibly inspiring to see the impact that people who share a common interest can make in the fight against cancer."

Among the participants were U.S. amateur golfer Matt Parziale, and his father, Vic Parziale, a retired Brockton firefighter, who played to help raise awareness about occupational cancer. Wellesley firefighter and cancer survivor, Joanie Cullinan, also participated with her brother, Brian Cullinan.

Colin Whitney raised \$16,317 and played to honor his sister, Caitlin Whitney, who used DetecTogether's education when she discovered a lump in her breast during a self-exam. "This organization helped my sister Caitlin detect breast cancer in the early stages," he says. "She is now 7 years cancer-free."

Henry Carr, 20, died from osteosarcoma in 2017. His father, Bob Carr, played in the Golf Marathon and his mother, Kim Carr, a 12-year cancer survivor, drove the golf cart to honor their son's memory. "As the outcome of his diagnosis became clearer, Henry would at times reflect on his fear that if he were gone, he would soon be forgotten," said Bob. "Jim Coghlin and the entire family at DetecTogether keep his memory alive through their expanding programs designed to help detect the signs of cancer when the chances of treating it are greater." The Carrs raised \$12,865.

Other top fundraisers included DetecTogether Board members Chris Coghlin, who raised \$75,150, Chris Palermo, who raised \$17,010, and Bill Durgin, who raised \$13,403. Jim Coghlin Jr. raised an impressive \$31,494, and Ian Levine raised \$28,389 to honor his son.

When the opportunity to support DetecTogether through the Golf Fights Cancer Golf Marathon presented itself, he signed up right away to honor his son, William, who at 20-years old, was diagnosed with Large B cell Non-Hodgkin Lymphoma in 2020. Will's diagnosis came after numerous trips to the doctor for a seemingly benign nighttime cough. While the world focused on COVID-19, Ian and his family spent the summer of 2020 through the fall of 2021 with Will at the hospital for chemotherapy and radiation treatments. They are grateful that Will found his tumor early, and most importantly, that he is now cancer-free!

As part of the Golf Marathon, Ian raised \$28,389 for DetecTogether and supports what we do. Ian said, "Demonstrating my butter smooth swing for 100 holes is the least I can do to help others and support DetecTogether." Ian personally matched every dollar donated to him, with his own gift of \$10,000.




